





### Sailing sessions

Signing up to sailings through the sailing calendar.

- The sailings are posted in the calendar in the beginning of each month. More sailings might pop up over time.
- Spontaneous sailings get announced in the Facebook group



- Only sign up to **one sailing at the time** (unless there is available spots 2h before a sailing start)
- All start times are definite, **be in time**. Ending time is estimated and can vary, so don't make plans for right after the sailing.
- Cancellation through the calendar up till 5h before the sailing.
  (call your skipper if you cannot go after that, or you're running late).
- We will be signing up to beginner sailings at the end of today's course.




